#### **Reading**

The children will be reading lots of different books with the focus being on woodland animals and Christmas.

The children will be encouraged to talk about things they observe and enjoy doing. We will be looking at the woodland animals such as foxes. hedgehogs and squirrels. The children will look at where the animals live and what they eat. We will also talk about Bonfire night and keeping safe. We will be talking about Christmas and the children will be sending letters to Santa. Personal, Social and

#### **Mathematics**
